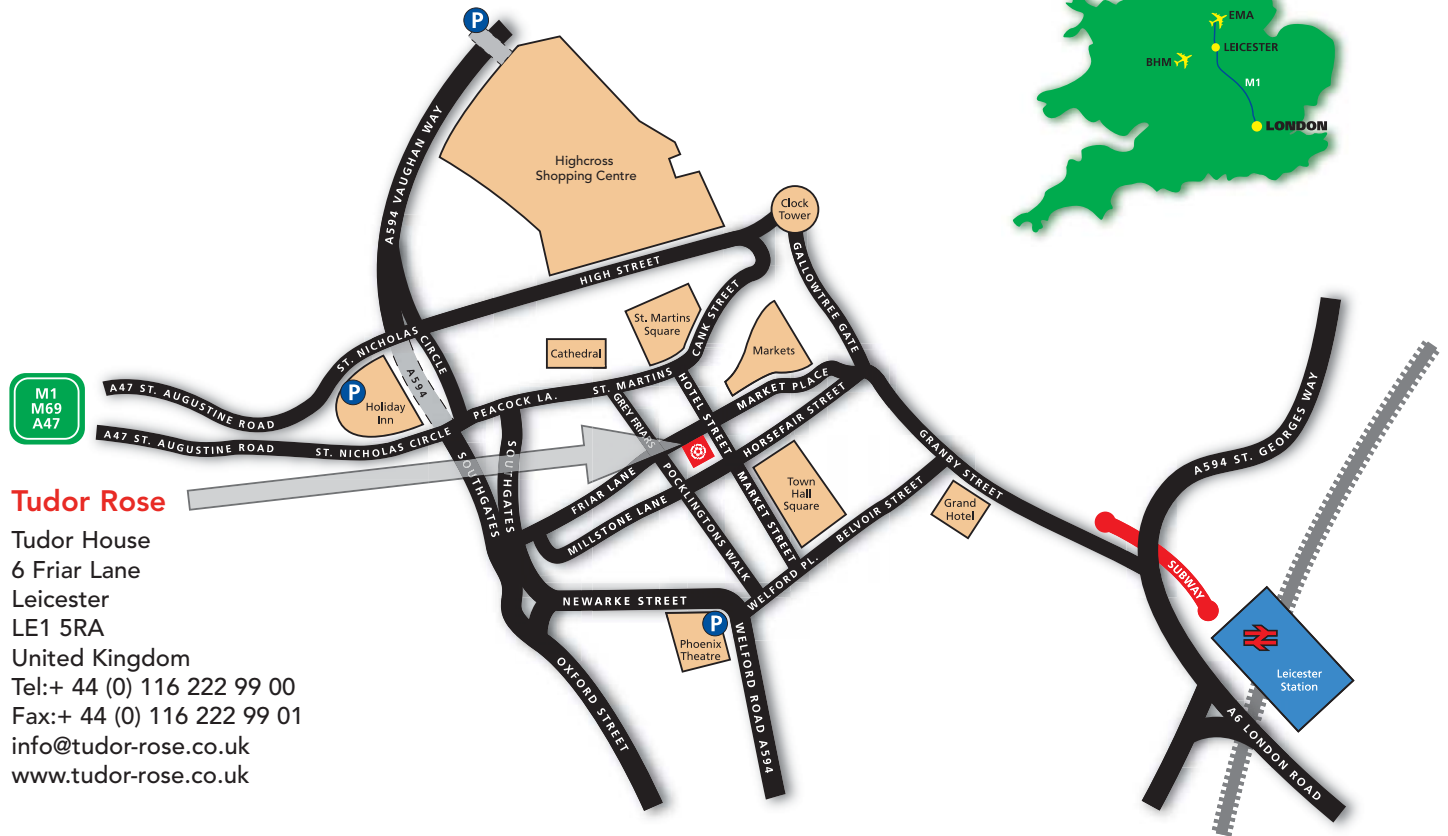




## How to find us...

Located in the centre of the United Kingdom, and approximately 100 miles north of London, Leicester is easily reached by road, rail or air.

### Road

- » The city centre is clearly signposted from junction 21 of the M1 motorway. Following the signs to the city centre will lead you via the A5460 to the A47, which takes you into the heart of the city.
- » As you approach the central business district, The Holiday Inn hotel will become clearly visible directly ahead of the road. As you approach the hotel, move into the right hand lane of the carriageway.
- » As you pass the hotel, you will then see an entrance to an NCP car park. This is the easiest car park to find, and approximately 5 minutes walk from the Tudor Rose offices.
- » This car park is situated on a very large roundabout, so if you miss it at the first attempt, you can easily continue right round the roundabout (and through a number of traffic lights) and enter on the second attempt.
- » Alternatively, there are a number of other parking areas, the most convenient of which is the Highcross shopping centre car park on Vaughan Way (see map for details).
- » Once you have parked, the offices should be easy to find by referring to the map.

### Rail

Leicester is serviced by the Midland Mainline, which runs to and from St Pancras station in London. Trains depart from London and Leicester approximately every half hour. There are usually plenty of taxis available at the station. Alternatively, the Tudor Rose offices are just 10 minutes walking distance from the station.

### Air

Both Birmingham International and East Midlands Airport have flights from most major European cities. The Tudor Rose offices are approximately 45 minutes by road from Birmingham and 30 minutes from East Midlands Airport.

Heathrow and Gatwick airports provide full international services into the UK – use road or rail directions from London. Travel time is approximately 3 hours from Heathrow and 3.5 hours from Gatwick, depending on train links and/or traffic.
